□ Two full years of housing history

□ If renting (or rented in the past 2 years) please bring the landlord's name, address and phone number along with the dates of residency and monthly rent paid

□ Your 2024 Social Security Benefit Letter. The 1099 form will not be acceptable. To obtain a copy of the letter please call 800-772-1213.

□ Your most recent bank statements including all: □Checking □Savings □Money Market □Trusts and IRA

□ If you own Real Estate, bring a copy of your most recent tax bill and mortgage statement if applicable

□ If you sold a home in the past 24 months, bring proof of the sale: closing statement, last tax bill showing fair market value

Bring any statements from Life Insurance Policies: statement needs to indicate current cash value

□ Bring any pension and/or retirement/annuity statements

□ If you own: stocks, bonds, mutual funds, or investment accounts or 401(k), please bring your current statements

□ If you have disposed f any assets in the last 24 months: car, home, life insurance policies, stocks, bonds or other assets or if you gave money away, bring an explanation stating:

U What kind of asset you disposed of

□ The amount, including any receipts

□Where the money is now

□ If you have received a lump sum payment in the last 24 months, bring proof

□ If employed, bring most recent check stub. If you are collecting unemployment, bring form showing the amount

□ Also you will need to provide a driver's license or ID as proof of age, and need to bring a check (or cash) for \$100.00 payable to Clare Meadows, LLC for the application deposit. Upon signing your lease, the \$100 will be applied to the security deposit. The security deposit is ½ of a month's rent.
